- Build a Propagation Shade House so our kids can learn the entire plant cycle, from seed to plant. This directly supports our sensory garden, forest area and membership in “Pick of the Crop”.
- Install new sporting equipment and surfaces such as a long jump run and shot put area for Sports day.
